

Complaining is common - we love to vent about our jobs our families and our finances.


Complaining isn't just expressing frustration It is a spiritual declaration that God Hasn't been good enough.

It shifts your heart from gratitude to negativity


It blinds you to blessings fuels anxiety And invites a spirit of discouragement

Luke 18

9 To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everyone else, **Jesus told this parable: 10 "Two men went up to the** temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. 11 The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other people-robbers, evildoers, adulterers-or even like this tax collector. 12 I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get.'13 "But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner.'14 "I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."

Then thank God for what he is doing in your own life even if it is still in process.


Your life is unfolding the way God designed it for you. You do need someone elses life. Celebrate your own and what God is doing in you.
